Topics

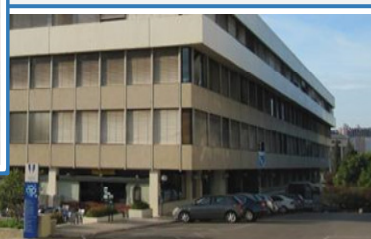
Major topics of interest for submission include, but are not limited to:

Authors of accepted short papers are encouraged to submit a full version of the papers at the workshop, which will be peer reviewed for inclusion in a volume of the ISTP indexed book series "IOS Studies on Applied Electromagnetic and Mechanics".

English is the official language of the workshop and will be used for all printed materials, presentations and discussions.

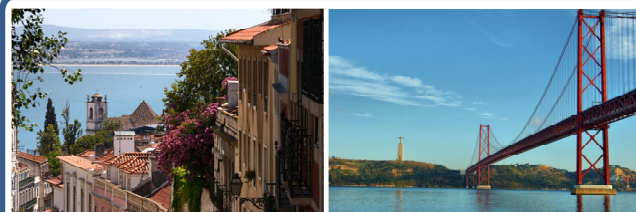
Access
